**AN ORDINANCE TO IMPOSE A TEMPORARY  
MORATORIUM  
ON SOLAR ENERGY FACILITIES.**

An Ordinance to protect the public health, safety, and welfare by establishing regulations relating to a moratorium on considering applications for Solar Energy Facilities in the Village in order to permit the Village Board of Appeals to consider whether to amend the Village Zoning Ordinance to provide for and regulate solar energy facilities within the Village; to provide for severability; to repeal all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict therewith; and to provide an effective date.

**THE VILLAGE OF CLIMAX  
KALAMAZOO COUNTY, MICHIGAN  
ORDAINS:  
SECTION I  
FINDINGS**

In accordance with Public Act 246 of 1945, MCL 41.181 et seq., as amended, the Village Council of the Village of Climax has determined the following:

1. Motivation for the use of Solar Energy Facilities as alternative source energy for the provision of energy to the electrical "grid" has become intensified as investor-owned utilities; municipal utilities; and co-op utilities, alone or in partnership with utility companies, third-parties, non-profits and building owners are seeking to meet alternative energy sources and reduce carbon emissions in the production of energy.
2. The Village's Zoning Ordinance does not presently contain any standards for solar energy facilities. As such, solar energy is not permitted in any zoning district in the village.
3. The Village Council has public health, safety, and welfare concerns regarding the potential implementation of solar energy facilities, particularly large-scale solar energy facilities or "solar farms" within the limited confines of the village.
4. The Village Council wishes to ensure that the Board of Appeals has sufficient time to consider and make recommendations of the implementation of solar energy systems within the Village.
5. The Village Council finds that imposing a moratorium upon the consideration of any applications for solar energy facilities, on a limited temporary basis, is reasonable and necessary for, among other reasons, the following reasons:
  - A. Michigan courts have recognized that a moratorium is a common and legitimate planning tool to preserve the status quo while formulating a development strategy.
  - B. The contemplated moratorium would allow the study of the public health, safety, and welfare concerns regarding the special use of solar energy facilities and to allow for any needed Zoning Ordinance update and implementation process to occur.
  - C. The contemplated moratorium would allow the study and possible implementation of revisions to the Zoning Ordinance to occur with citizen input and involvement, public debate, and full consideration of all issues and points of view.
  6. The contemplated moratorium would allow for consideration of changes in land use and demand for solar energy facilities; and to consider and make any necessary amendments to the Zoning Ordinance.

**SECTION II  
MORATORIUM**

A moratorium is imposed upon the consideration of any applications for Solar Energy Facilities in the Village for 180 days or until the Board of Appeals of the village has had ample opportunity to consider the potential use and implementation of solar energy facilities in the Village, and to provide standards and regulations related thereto; whichever occurs first.

**SECTION III  
TERM OF MORATORIUM**

The moratorium imposed by this ordinance will remain in effect for 180 days after the effective date of this ordinance, or until amendments the Village has adopted related thereto have been added to the Village Zoning Ordinance. Before this moratorium expires, the Village Council may by resolution extend the moratorium as appropriate to allow sufficient time to complete its study and propose ordinance amendments, if any. If an extension is adopted, the Village will publish notice of the extension.

**SECTION IV  
SEVERABILITY**

The provisions of this ordinance are hereby declared to be severable. If any clause, sentence, word, section or provision is hereafter declared void or unenforceable for any reason by a court of competent jurisdiction, it shall not affect the remainder of such ordinance which shall continue in full force and effect.

**SECTION V  
REPEAL**

All ordinance or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

**SECTION VI  
EFFECTIVE DATE**

This ordinance shall take effect on the tenth day after publication, after adoption.
